**To beat the season pass rush and avoid waiting in long lines, you may purchase your passes prior to Opening Day. The Borough will be selling swimming pool passes on Monday, May 18 from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. and Wednesday May 20, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Emmaus Community Park swimming pool office. Please complete the form at the bottom of this page and bring it with you when you are purchasing your passes to help expedite the process. Proof of residency will be required for any passes charged at the resident rate.**

Please note that a family membership is limited to mother, father, and children living in the same household. Also, children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult or they will be denied access to the pool. The Borough enforces a policy of zero tolerance for inappropriate behavior, which means misbehaving patrons will be banned from the pool for the season, without refund for this season pass.

**Swim lessons will be offered in July and spaces are limited. Please see the Pool Manager for further information.**

Those who do not want to purchase a season pass are invited to use the pool on a daily basis.

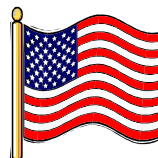
## Summer Concerts at Community Park
