

PARK, POOL AND PAVILION REGULATIONS - 2010

- **NO** Bicycle Riding, In-line Skating, Skate Boarding
- **NO** Lawn Darts
- **NO** Fireworks
- **NO** Pets
- **NO** Hitting Golf Balls
- **NO** Gambling
- **NO** Liquor or Wine
- **NO** Tents of any kind without prior approval from Parks and Recreation Commission
- **NO** Metal Detecting

Quoits and horse shoe playing is permitted in designated areas only.

Beer and soda are permitted in cans or kegs. Beer must be kept in the picnic area. No walking around the park with beer.

Occupancy limits for pavilions will be strictly enforced. Pavilions are to be left in a clean condition. Additional charges will be assessed for overbooking of pavilions, and/or excessive cleaning of the pavilion.

The park is open from sunrise until 9:00 p.m. with the exception of Legion Ballfield that has special times when games are in session. The pavilions are available for rental from May through September only. The Rotary Club and Moser Pavilions are available for rental after September 30th until October 31st.

Baseball field use must be authorized by Park Personnel. **No Monopolizing of fields!** Frisbees, soccer balls, footballs, baseballs, etc. are only allowed at the fields, **not in the picnic areas.**

*Performing Arts Pavilion Rules & Regulations:

1. Food and beverages are permitted. However, the preparation of the food and dispensing of the beverages must be done outside of the pavilion. (i.e. charcoal, electric or gas grills and beer kegs).
2. The Performing Arts Pavilion cannot be reserved on Sundays due to the Summer Concert Series.

3. Only catering vehicles may remain at the Arts Pavilion area. All other vehicles must have equipment unloaded by 12:00 noon and are not to be reloaded until 8:00 p.m.

NOISE LIMITATIONS

All patrons who use the Borough's parks are required to monitor all sound devices so that sound levels are not offensive to other park users. Any pavilions rentals which plan to utilize a band(s) or disc jockey will require prior approval from the Borough. Any patron who does not comply with maintaining proper sound levels, as determined by a Borough representative, will forfeit usage of the park or pavilion and any fees paid.

POOL FEES AND INFORMATION:

The Pool is open Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend, provided there are adequate lifeguards to staff the pool. Pool is open daily, 12:00 noon until 8:00 p.m., adult swim on Tues and Thurs, 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., weather and other conditions permitting. Season passes or daily tickets must be presented for pool admission. Food is only allowed in the refreshment stand area. Smoking is not allowed in the pool area. Only children 10 years or older may be left at the pool without adult supervision.
