To beat the season pass rush and avoid waiting in long lines, you may purchase your passes prior to Opening Day. The Borough will be selling swimming pool passes on Tuesday May 13th from 1PM -3PM and Friday May 16th from 4:30PM - 7PM at the Emmaus Community Park swimming pool office. Please complete the form at the bottom of this page and bring it with you when you are purchasing your passes to help expedite the process. Proof of residency will be required for any passes charged at the resident rate.

The rates for 2008 are as follows:

Please note that a family membership is limited to mother, father, and children living in the same household. Also, children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult or they will be denied access to the pool. The Borough enforces a policy of zero tolerance for bad behavior, which means those patrons who are misbehaving will be banned from the pool for the season.

A new feature for the 2008 swim pool year are the addition of 2 large shaded structures (18 feet by 40 feet) for patrons utilizing the swimming pool complex that are located on the concrete deck at the corner of the baby pool and mid point in the main pool.

Swim lessons will be offered in July and spaces are limited so please see pool manager for further information.

Those who do not want to purchase a season pass are invited to use the pool on a daily basis.
